Trinitytide (p 281)

From Trinity Sunday until Saturday before Advent I. Trinitytide consists of at least 23 and at most 27 Sundays, due to the variable date of Easter. The propers for the 25th, 26th, and 27th Sundays after Trinity shall be used on the last three Sundays of the Church Year regardless of the actual enumeration of those Sundays.

For Holy Trinity and the week thereafter:

Invitatory: The true God, One in Three and Three in One: O come, let us worship Him.

Antiphons for Psalms (appropriate for use on Feasts and Sundays).

Common of Saints (p 311)

Common of the Blessed Virgin Mary (B.V.M.)

Invitatory: Let us keep holiday in honor of the Virgin Mary: Let us worship the Virgin's Son, Christ the Lord.

Antiphons for Psalms

1. Quando venit ergo sacri plenitudo temporis : missus est ab arce Patris natus, orbis conditor in terris.
2. Stirps Jesae virgam produxit, virgaque florem, et super hunc florem requiescat Spiritus almus : Virgo Dei genitrix virga est, flos Filius ejus.
3. The stem of Jesse shall produce a rod, and the rod a flower, and the nourishing Spirit shall rest upon Him : the virgin mother of God is the rod, her Son the flower.
